

HOW YOUR CONTRIBUTIONS WILL DIRECTLY SUPPORT OUR SCIENTISTS

Regular and stable funding via a Workplace Giving Program is vital to the ongoing work of our scientists. Lower administrative costs involved for the Institute means that a greater portion of the donation can directly support their life saving research, getting them closer to better understanding and finding cures for chronic diseases.

\$5 each week (or \$260 per year) - will purchase a Pipette Aid which allows our researchers to accurately and safely transfer liquids during delicate procedures.

\$10 each fortnight (or \$260 per year) - will provide four researchers with safety laboratory coats to protect their skin and personal clothing from dangerous chemical spills or splashes.

\$25 each month (or \$300 per year) - will cover the cost of six hours of much-needed imaging time for researchers to evaluate and analyse their research findings.

\$30 each month (or \$360 per year) - will purchase a laboratory grade microwave which assists our researchers to stain microscopic tissue samples or undertake moisture testing.

\$45 each month (or \$540 per year) - will buy a personal Micro Minifuge which is used to microfilter samples and separate cells, allowing more studies and faster results.

\$60 each month (or \$720 per year) - will purchase a heated Magnetic Stirrer that allows our researchers to both stir and heat liquids in the one glass vessel.

20 employees contributing \$17 per month each and their employer matching these gifts - will provide a Centenary scientist with financial support to attend a conference or seminar to keep up to date with inspiring advances and gain insights from other areas.

Our Workplace Giving Program enables you to donate to our life saving research via pre-tax deductions from your salary straight to the Centenary Institute - all you have to do is nominate the amount you wish to contribute from each pay cycle.
